Motion was made by Dean Smith and seconded by Al Britt that the Coffee County Commission authorize LifeSouth Community Blood Centers to host a blood drive at County Complex on December 22, 2009. Additional blood drives will be held at the County Courthouses with dates and times to be announced. All voted Aye.

Commissioners Robert Stephens and Bernest Brooks reflected on war history and expressed their gratitude for our present freedoms.

With no further business, motion was made by Kim Ellis and seconded by Al Britt that the Coffee County Commission adjourn until the next meeting, November 23, 2009. All voted Aye.
