

DRIVEWAY PIPE POLICY

COFFEE COUNTY

EFFECTIVE DATE: October 26, 1998

ALLOWABLE PIPES: Only corrugated metal or reinforced concrete pipe shall be used.

All corrugated metal pipes must be new. Used reinforced concrete pipes may be used subject to the County Engineer's approval. **PLASTIC PIPE IS NOT ALLOWABLE.**

PROCEDURES: Citizens requesting a driveway pipe must contact the County Engineer's Office at (334) 894-6112. Someone from the Engineer's Office will then go out and size the pipe. The citizen will be contacted as to what size pipe is needed. The citizen then has a choice of whether to obtain the pipe themselves or have the County furnish the pipe at a prescribed rate. If the citizen obtains his own pipe, it will, under normal conditions, be installed by the County within two (2) weeks from the date the citizen notifies the County that the pipe has been delivered. If the County supplies the pipe, it will be installed within two (2) weeks of the County receiving payment for the pipe.

PIPE LENGTHS: Driveway pipes shall be a minimum of 30 feet long for diameters 18 inches and greater. 15 inch diameter pipes may have a minimum of 20 feet length. All pipes shall have a maximum length of 100 feet.
