On this the 28<sup>th</sup> day of April 2008 at 9:00 A.M. in the Office Complex, New Brockton, AL, the Coffee County Commission of Coffee County, AL met in a regular meeting. Those present at the said meeting were: Bernest Brooks, Douglas Dalrymple, Robert Stephens, Jim Thompson, J. L. Weeks, and Linda Westbrook. Tom Grimsley, Commissioner and Chairman, was presiding with no absences.

The Chairman noted that a quorum was present and the meeting was called to order. Invocation was given by Commissioner Brooks.

Motion was made by J. L. Weeks and seconded by Bernest Brooks that the Coffee County Commission approve the Minutes of the April 12, 2008 meeting. All voted Aye.

Motion was made by Tom Grimsley and seconded by Jim Thompson that the Coffee County Commission award the Publication of the Voters' List to The Southeast Sun. All voted Aye.

The following bids were opened for Jail Telephone and Management Systems:

Securus Technologies	48.5% based on 3 year contract
Digital Solutions	45% based on 3 year contract

Motion was made by Jim Thompson and seconded by Bernest Brooks that the Coffee County Commission accept the bid of 48.5% gross for three (3) years from Securus Technologies as recommended by the Jail Administrator. The County Attorney also clarified that a three year contract does fall within the guidelines of the State. All voted Aye.

Motion was made by Tom Grimsley and seconded by J. L. Weeks that the Coffee County Commission send out bids for Oil and Lubricants for the Highway Department. All voted Aye.

Motion was made by Jim Thompson and seconded by Douglas Dalrymple that the Coffee County Commission send out bids for 40 yd. containers for the County Roll-Off Department. All voted Aye.

The County Engineer advised that notification be given to all users of the County Landfill that effective October 1, 2008 a \$1.00 per ton disposal fee will be assessed as authorized by the State.

Motion was made by J. L. Weeks and seconded by Douglas Dalrymple that the Coffee County Commission extend the current lease with the Farm Service Agency to expire June 30, 2010 in order to allow adequate time to negotiate a long-term lease. Terms will remain the same. All voted Aye.

Motion was made by Linda Westbrook and seconded by Robert Stephens that the Coffee County Commission waive the rental fee of the Coffee County Farm Center to allow area churches to sponsor a youth revival May 12-17, 2008. All voted Aye.

Motion was made by Tom Grimsley and seconded by Jim Thompson that the Coffee County Commission reschedule the second meeting in May to be held on Tuesday, May 27, 2008, due to Monday being Memorial Day. All voted Aye.

With no further business, the meeting was adjourned until May 12, 2008 at 9:00 A.M. in the Office Complex, New Brockton, AL.
