On this the 25<sup>th</sup> day of February 2008 at 9:00 A.M. in the Office Complex, New Brockton, AL, the Coffee County Commission of Coffee County, AL met in a regular meeting. Those present at the said meeting were: Bernest Brooks, Robert Stephens, Jim Thompson, J. L. Weeks, and Linda Westbrook. Tom Grimsley, Commissioner and Chairman, was presiding with one absent, Douglas Dalrymple.

The Chairman noted that a quorum was present and the meeting was called to order. The invocation and pledge was given by Commissioner Weeks.

The following bid was opened for Oil & Lubricants:

Motion was made by Bernest Brooks and seconded by J. L. Weeks that the Coffee County Commission send out invitations to bid on Undercarriage Repair to D-6 Dozer. All voted Aye.

Motion was made by Jim Thompson and seconded by Robert Stephens that the Coffee County Commission send out invitations to bid on a new water tanker for the County Landfill. All voted Aye.

Motion was made by Jim Thompson and seconded by Bernest Brooks that the Coffee County Commission approve the final plat for the Hunter Ridge Subdivision Phase III. All voted Aye.

Motion was made by Robert Stephens and seconded by J. L. Weeks that the County Highway Department assist the City of Elba in digging up old pipes. This will require about six hours of excavator time. All voted Aye.

Motion was made by Linda Westbrook and seconded by Robert Stephens that the Coffee County Commission reappoint Mr. Troy Dunn to the South Crenshaw Water Authority. All voted Aye.

Motion was made by Tom Grimsley and seconded by Linda Westbrook that the Coffee County Commission authorize the placement of surplus equipment from the Sheriff's Department vehicles to be sold on GovDeals. All voted Aye.

After a short review of the Oil and Lubricants Bid, it was noted that the calculations were incorrect on the low bid of Davis Oil Company. The correct amount is \$13,784.34--still being the low bidder. Motion was made by Jim Thompson and seconded by Robert Stephens that the Coffee County Commission accept the bid from Davis Oil Company (with its corrections) being the low bidder and upon the recommendation of County Engineer and the County Attorney. All voted Aye.

With no further business, the meeting was adjourned by the Chairman to sign bills.
