Motion was made by Bernest Brooks and seconded by J. L. Weeks that the Coffee County Commission accept the Annual Tax Settlement Report as presented by Revenue Commissioner Ronnie Burns. All voted Aye.

Mr. John Griggs, Sr. and John Griggs, Jr., representatives of AWA Worldwide Championship Wrestling came before the Commission to request permission to host wrestling events in the Coffee County Farm Center.

Motion was made by Tom Grimsley and seconded by J. L. Weeks that the Coffee County Commission send out bids for Lime/Fertilizer. All voted Aye.

Motion was made by Linda Westbrook and seconded by Bernest Brooks that the Coffee County Commission send out bids for Assisted hauling for the Coffee County Highway Department. All voted Aye.

Motion was made by Bernest Brooks and seconded by J. L. Weeks that the Coffee County Commission approve the expense of additional mileage for those jurors traveling to the County Courthouse in Enterprise for a trial previously scheduled for the County Courthouse in Elba. Judge Kelley made this request due to undue hardships for severe disabilities. Bernest Brooks, Douglas Dalrymple, Tom Grimsley, Jim Thompson, J. L. Weeks, and Linda Westbrook voted Affirmative. Robert Stephens Abstained. Motion carried.

Special recognition, thanks, and brief synopsis of Bamalam Festival were offered by EMA Director John Tallas, Sheriff Dave Sutton, and Commissioner Jim Thompson.

Motion was made by J. L. Weeks and seconded by Linda Westbrook that the Coffee County Commission purchase additional air conditioning for Chestnut Grove Voting House and Frisco Voting House.

Motion was made by Robert Stephens and seconded by J. L. Weeks that the Coffee County Commission amend the motion to include Pleasant Ridge Voting House. Douglas Dalrymple, Tom Grimsley, Robert Stephens, J. L. Weeks, and Linda Westbrook voted Affirmative. Bernest Brooks and Jim Thompson voted Negative. Motion to amend carried.
