Tom Grimsley, Commissioner and Chairman, was presiding with no absences.

The Chairman noted that a quorum was present and the meeting was called to order. Invocation and pledge was given by Commissioner Weeks.

Motion was made by Linda Westbrook and seconded by J. L. Weeks that the Coffee County Commission authorize the County Maintenance Department to build a shed at the Zion Chapel Senior Center for its bus, whenever time is permissible. All voted Aye.

Motion was made by Robert Stephens and seconded by Tom Grimsley that the Coffee County Commission approve the purchase of a portable air conditioning unit for the Commission Office. The estimated cost is \$500.00. All voted Aye.

Motion was made by Tom Grimsley and seconded by Linda Westbrook that the Coffee County Commission clarify a motion made in Commission meeting on June 11, 2007, regarding annual leave for Kathy Lolley. It was the intent of the Commission to give 120.12 hours of annual leave at hire date, as part of the compensation package, to give credit for prior year services with the county. Douglas Dalrymple, Tom Grimsley, Robert Stephens, Jim Thompson, J. L. Weeks, and Linda Westbrook voted Affirmative. Bernest Brooks Abstained. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Tom Grimsley and seconded by J. L. Weeks that the Coffee County Commission purchase an E150 van for the IT Manager from the State bid list for \$14,658.56. All voted Aye.

Motion was made by Tom Grimsley and seconded by Douglas Dalrymple that the Coffee County Commission place the green van previously used by the IT Manager on Gov Deals site. All voted Aye.
