Tom Grimsley, Commissioner and Chairman, was presiding with no absences.

The Chairman noted that a quorum was present and the meeting was called to order. Invocation and pledge was given by Chairman Grimsley.

Mr. Stan Windham, County Agent, thanked Commissioners Douglas Dalrymple and Linda Westbrook for their numerous years of dedication and presented them with plaques of appreciation.

Motion was made by Jim Thompson and seconded by J. L. Weeks that the Coffee County Commission approve the Minutes of the April 28, 2008 meeting. All voted Aye.

Motion was made by Tom Grimsley and seconded by J. L. Weeks that the Coffee County Commission accept the low bid of \$7084.64 from Davis Oil Company, Dothan, AL. All voted Aye.

Mr. Robert Lolley, Veteran Affairs Administrator, appeared before the Commission to announce his retirement effective June 1, 2008. He thanked the Commission for their support during his 28 year tenure.

Motion was made by Robert Stephens and seconded by J. L. Weeks that the Coffee County Commission present Mr. Robert Lolley with a Proclamation of Appreciation at the next meeting. All voted Aye.

Motion was made by J. L. Weeks and seconded by Jim Thompson that the Coffee County Commission approve the Landfill credit application from One Stop Environmental. All voted Aye.

Motion was made by Linda Westbrook and seconded by Robert Stephens that the Coffee County Commission approve the franchise agreement from Troy Cable Company. All voted Aye.

Motion was made by Bernest Brooks and seconded by Linda Westbrook that the Coffee County Commission adopt a resolution to serve as emergency backup support to assist County agencies should the need arise during the BamaJam Festival. Reimbursement for any additional cost will be covered by Ronnie Gilley. Bernest Brooks, Tom Grimsley, Robert Stephens, Jim Thompson, J. L. Weeks, and Linda Westbrook voted Affirmative. Douglas Dalrymple voted Negative. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Bernest Brooks and seconded by Tom Grimsley that the Coffee County Commission support the request of the Mayor of Enterprise to assist in the improvements to be made at the Farmers' Market at an amount that is feasible. Bernest Brooks and Tom Grimsley voted Affirmative. Douglas Dalrymple, Jim Thompson, J. L. Weeks, and Linda Westbrook voted Negative. Robert Stephens Abstained. Motion did not carry.

Motion was made by Robert Stephens and seconded by Linda Westbrook that the Coffee County Commission support the City of Enterprise in theory but that no funds be obligated at this time. Dalrymple, Tom Grimsley, Robert Stephens, J. L. Weeks, and Linda Westbrook voted Affirmative. Bernest Brooks and Jim Thompson voted Negative. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Robert Stephens and seconded by J. L. Weeks that the Coffee County Commission permit the County Maintenance Department to rent or borrow a bucket truck to repaint the drain pipes as needed at the County Courthouse in Elba, AL. Douglas Dalrymple, Tom Grimsley, Robert Stephens, Jim Thompson, J. L. Weeks, and Linda Westbrook voted Affirmative. Bernest Brooks Abstained. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Douglas Dalrymple and seconded by J. L. Weeks that the Coffee County Commission replace the fire alarm system in the Mt. Pleasant Senior Center which has never worked. The estimated price should be under \$1,000.00. Douglas Dalrymple, Tom Grimsley, Robert Stephens, Jim Thompson, J. L. Weeks, and Linda Westbrook voted Affirmative. Bernest Brooks Abstained. Motion carried.

Motion was made by J. L. Weeks and seconded by Tom Grimsley that the Coffee County Commission adjourn until the next meeting, Tuesday, May 27, 2008 at 9:00 A.M. All voted Aye.
