Motion was made by Robert Stephens and seconded by Linda Westbrook that the Coffee County Commission hire Lawford Construction to perform the necessary repairs to the outside of the second floor of the County Courthouse in Elba, AL. The estimated cost of repairs will not exceed \$3,500.00. The two wooden doors will be replaced with two metal doors. All materials will be furnished by the Commission. All voted Aye.

Motion was made by Linda Westbrook and seconded by Tom Grimsley that the Coffee County Commission adjourn until the next meeting. All voted Aye.
