

November 27, 2023

On this the 27th day of November 2023, the Coffee County Commission met in Commission Chambers in New Brockton, AL at 9:00 AM. Those present at the said meeting were: Kim Ellis, Sonny Moore, Al Britt, Jimmy Jones, and Jim Thompson. Tom Grimsley, Commissioner/Vice-Chairman, was presiding. Dean Smith was absent. John R. Morgan III, Administrator/Attorney, was also in attendance.

Vice-Chairman Grimsley noted that a quorum was present and called the meeting to order. Invocation was given by Commissioner Ellis followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Motion was made by Commissioner Moore and seconded by Commissioner Jones that the Coffee County Commission adopt the minutes from the November 13, 2023 meeting. All voted Aye.

Motion was made by Commissioner Ellis and seconded by Commissioner Britt that the Coffee County Commission authorize and approve a pay increase for the County's deputies/correction officers as presented at the work session. All raises will be effective with the first pay period of 2024. All voted Aye.

Motion was made by Commissioner Britt and seconded by Commissioner Thompson that the Coffee County Commission authorize its Solid Waste Enforcement Officer to issue citations for violations of State law pursuant to the State Code. All voted Aye.

Motion was made by Commissioner Moore and seconded by Commissioner Jones that the Coffee County Commission change the voting location from the Elba National Armory to the Elba Masonic Lodge for the 2024 election cycle. All voted Aye.

County offices will be closed Friday, December 22nd and Monday, December 25th for the Christmas holidays.

The highway department will be closed December 25-29, 2023.

Residential garbage service will not run on Christmas Day or New Years Day.

County Agent Gavin Mauldin stated the row crop course will be December 14-15, 2023 at Auburn.

Chief Deputy Hines thanked the Commission for the pay increase for the deputies and correction officers.

With no further business to discuss, motion was made by Commissioner Britt and seconded by Commissioner Thompson that the Coffee County Commission adjourn until the next meeting on December 11, 2023. All voted Aye.
