

January 22, 2024

On this the 22nd day of January 2024, the Coffee County Commission met in Commission Chambers in New Brockton, AL at 9:00 AM. Those present at the said meeting were: Kim Ellis, Sonny Moore, Jimmy Jones, Jim Thompson, and Tom Grimsley. Dean Smith, Commissioner/Chairman, was presiding. Al Britt was absent. John R. Morgan III, Administrator, Chief Operating Officer, and Attorney, was also in attendance.

Chairman Smith noted that a quorum was present and called the meeting to order. Invocation was given by Commissioner Jones followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Motion was made by Commissioner Grimsley and seconded by Commissioner Jones that the Coffee County Commission adopt the minutes from the January 8, 2024 meeting. All voted Aye.

Chairman Smith introduced the new mayor of New Brockton, Charles “Chuck” Schieffer.

Motion was made by Commissioner Moore and seconded by Commissioner Jones that the Coffee County Commission approve the proposal with JM Wood Auction Compnay selling five dump trucks and six tractors for a minimum guaranteed price of \$1,182,500 with a 7% commission rate. All voted Aye.

Motion was made by Commissioner Ellis and seconded by Commissioner Smith that the Coffee County Commission grant permission to send out bids for five-16’ automatic dump beds as requested by County Engineer Michael Walters. All voted Aye.

Motion was made by Commissioner Grimsley and seconded by Commissioner Thompson that the Coffee County Commission grant permission to surplus and sell several pieces of equipment at the Landfill on GovDeals as requested by Environmental Services Director Mike Thornton. All voted Aye.

Dean Blair, E911, welcomed the new mayor.

County Agent Gavin Mauldin updated the Commission on upcoming events. A restricted use pesticide training will be held on February 6th and the Cotton Expo will be in Dothan on February 9th.

The Commissioners also welcomed Mayor Schieffer.

With no further business to discuss, motion was made by Commissioner Grimsley and seconded by Commissioner Moore that the Coffee County Commission adjourn until the next meeting on February 12, 2024. All voted Aye.
