

February 26, 2024

On this the 26th day of February 2024, the Coffee County Commission met in Commission Chambers in New Brockton, AL at 9:00 AM. Those present at the said meeting were: Kim Ellis, Sonny Moore, Al Britt, Jimmy Jones, Jim Thompson, and Tom Grimsley. Dean Smith, Commissioner/Chairman, was presiding. John R. Morgan III, Administrator, Chief Operating Officer, and Attorney, was also in attendance.

Chairman Smith noted that a quorum was present and called the meeting to order. Invocation was given by Commissioner Thompson followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Motion was made by Commissioner Grimsley and seconded by Commissioner Jones that the Coffee County Commission adopt the minutes from the February 12, 2024 meeting. All voted Aye.

County Administrator Rod Morgan read the results of a bid opening held on February 20, 2024 at 10:00 AM:

**Bid#2024-09 Pursuit SUV (2 each or more, new, unused 2023 or 2024)
Donohoo Chevrolet-\$49,375 per vehicle**

Motion was made by Commissioner Ellis and seconded by Commissioner Thompson that the Coffee County Commission award Bid#2024-09 to Donohoo Chevrolet, and allow the purchase of two vehicles. All voted Aye.

Motion was made by Commissioner Moore and seconded by Commissioner Britt that the Coffee County Commission reject Bid#2024-11 Tahoe PPV Equipment Bid. All voted Aye.

Motion was made by Commissioner Jones and seconded by Commissioner Smith that the Coffee County Commission join the ACCA and other counties in the state supporting Amendment 1 in the upcoming March election. All voted Aye.

Motion was made by Commissioner Ellis and seconded by Commissioner Britt that the Coffee County Commission award Bid#2024-08 16' Steel Dump Body to the only respondent, Childersburg Truck Service, for \$33,457 per unit, and approve the purchase of five units at the awarded bid price. All voted Aye.

Environmental Services Director Mike Thornton opened three bids on February 22, 2024, for one or two 2024 Roll-Off Trucks. He requested that Bid#2024-10 be awarded to the lowest bidder, Premier Truck Sales, for \$252,500 per truck, and would like to purchase two Kenworth T80 trucks at the bid price. Motion was made by Commissioner Thompson and seconded by Commissioner Moore that the Coffee County Commission honor the request. All voted Aye.

Sheriff Byrd thanked the Commission for the pursuit vehicles.

With no further to discuss, motion was made by Commissioner Grimsley and seconded by Commissioner Moore that the Coffee County Commission adjourn until the next meeting on March 11, 2024. All voted Aye.
