

November 25, 2024

On this the 25th day of November 2024, the Coffee County Commission met in Commission Chambers in New Brockton, AL at 9:00 AM. Those present at the said meeting were: Clint Grantham, Sonny Moore, Joey Powell, Jimmy Jones, and Jim Thompson. Kim Ellis, Commissioner/Chairman, was presiding. Al Miller was absent. John R. Morgan III, County Administrator, Attorney, and Chief Operating Officer, was also in attendance.

Chairman Ellis noted that a quorum was present and called the meeting to order. He also gave the invocation followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Motion was made by Commissioner Moore and seconded by Commissioner Jones that the Coffee County Commission adopt the minutes from the November 13, 2024 meeting. All voted Aye.

Motion was made by Commissioner Grantham and seconded by Commissioner Moore that the Coffee County Commission award Bid#2025-05-Pursuit SUV to the only respondent, Donohoo Chevrolet, for \$48,516.50. All voted Aye.

County Engineer Michael Walters came before the Commission to request the approval of a minor subdivision plat, Cool Springs Subdivision, located on CR708. This subdivision consists of three one acre lots, and meets the subdivision regulations. Motion was made by Commissioner Powell and seconded by Commissioner Ellis that the Coffee County Commission approve the Cool Springs Subdivision. All voted Aye.

Motion was made by Commissioner Jones and seconded by Commissioner Ellis that the Coffee County Commission enter into an agreement with Progressive Environmental Services as the sole source contractor to clean three Landfill Gas Wells for \$17,900, and one LFG Sump and collection line for \$29,900 as requested by Environmental Services Director Mike Thornton. All voted Aye.

James Brown, 911 Director, reminded the Commission of the 911 Board meeting on December 3rd.

County Agent Gavin Mauldin updated the Commission on upcoming events.

Sheriff Byrd noted that they were down to 150 inmates at the jail.

The Commissioners' thanked the county employees for making their job easier, and wished everyone a Happy Thanksgiving.

With no further business to discuss, motion was made by Commissioner Moore and seconded by Commissioner Thompson that the Coffee County Commission adjourn until the next meeting on December 9, 2024. All voted Aye.
