

June 9, 2025

On this the 9th day of June 2025, the Coffee County Commission met in Commission Chambers in New Brockton, AL at 9:00 AM. Those present at the said meeting were: Clint Grantham, Sonny Moore, Joey Powell, Jimmy Jones, Jim Thompson, and Al Miller. Kim Ellis, Commissioner/Chairman, was presiding. John R. Morgan III, Administrator, Attorney, and Chief Operating Officer, was also in attendance.

Chairman Ellis noted that a quorum was present and called the meeting to order. He also gave the invocation followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Chairman Ellis read and presented a resolution honoring Jay Wilson, member of the Elba High School Golf team, for winning the 2025 AHSAA Boys Class 1A-2A State Individual Championship. This was his second consecutive individual state title.

Motion was made by Commissioner Moore and seconded by Commissioner Jones that the Coffee County Commission adopt the minutes from the May 12, 2025 meeting. All voted Aye.

Motion was made by Commissioner Miller and seconded by Commissioner Powell that the Coffee County Commission approve a three-year contract for accounting software with DebtBook at a cost of \$18,500 for the first year and \$15,000 for the second and third year. All voted Aye.

Motion was made by Commissioner Powell and seconded by Commissioner Grantham that the Coffee County Commission approve a proposed plat for a minor subdivision, Sardis Landing, located on CR723 as requested by County Engineer Michael Walters. This plat consists of two lots and has met all the county subdivision regulations. All voted Aye.

Motion was made by Commissioner Ellis and seconded by Commissioner Thompson that the Coffee County Commission enter into a construction agreement with ALDOT for a Federal Aid Project to resurface CR114 starting at Wayne Farms to CR147. All voted Aye.

Motion was made by Commissioner Miller and seconded by Commissioner Grantham that the Coffee County Commission grant permission to Environmental Services Director Mike Thornton to purchase a Komatsu D61 dozer for \$407,547.79 off the Sourcewell bid. All voted Aye.

EMA Director Grant Lyons announced that June 1st kicked off hurricane season. He encouraged all the citizens of Coffee County to sign up for the mass notification system through the county website to receive important weather updates.

County Agent Gavin Mauldin updated the Commission on upcoming events.

Sheriff Byrd asked for prayers for the family of Sgt. Anthony Dozier who passed away on June 7th.

The Commissioners congratulated Jay on winning the state title and asked for prayers for the Dozier family.

With no further business to discuss, motion was made by Chairman Ellis and seconded by Commissioner Thompson that the Coffee County Commission adjourn until the next meeting on June 23, 2025. All voted Aye.
