

July 14, 2025

On this the 14th day of July 2025, the Coffee County Commission met in Commission Chambers in New Brockton, AL at 9:00 AM. Those present at the said meeting were: Clint Grantham, Sonny Moore, Joey Powell, Jimmy Jones, Jim Thompson, and Al Miller. Kim Ellis, Commissioner/Chairman, was presiding. John R. Morgan III, Administrator, Attorney, and Chief Operating Officer, was also in attendance.

Chairman Ellis noted that a quorum was present and called the meeting to order. Invocation was given by Commissioner Moore followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Motion was made by Commissioner Moore and seconded by Commissioner Jones that the Coffee County Commission adopt the minutes from the June 23, 2025 meeting. All voted Aye.

Motion was made by Commissioner Thompson and seconded by Commissioner Powell that the Coffee County Commission enter into a five-year license agreement with Cisco with financing through US Bank Corporation for \$28,103.57 per year. All voted Aye.

Motion was made by Commissioner Miller and seconded by Commissioner Ellis that the Coffee County Commission enter into a contract with the State of Alabama for funding available to make improvements at the Coffee County Lake for \$400,000. All voted Aye.

Motion was made by Commissioner Jones and seconded by Commissioner Miller that the Coffee County Commission approve the records request policy as presented at the last work session. All voted Aye.

Motion was made by Commissioner Thompson and seconded by Commissioner Ellis that the Coffee County Commission approve and adopt the social media policy as presented at the previous work session. Commissioners Ellis, Moore, Powell, Jones, Thompson, and Miller voted Aye. Commissioner Grantham voted Nay. This motion passed 6-1.

EMA Director Grant Lyons stated he's watching a possible weather disturbance in the Gulf later this week. EMA Deputy Director Andy Lore announced that a grant had been approved through CSX Transportation for \$5,000 as part of their Military and First Responder Grant program.

County Agent Gavin Mauldin said the Coffee County 4H Jr. Livestock Judging team won the state competition in Auburn and the Coffee County 4H Sr. Livestock Judging team placed third. There will be a sheep and goat meeting in August, and a food preservation class will be held at Enterprise State Community College in September.

Sheriff Byrd said there are forty-three participants at the Jr. Deputy Academy this week. They will have a graduation ceremony on Friday.

Coffee County Coroner Arnold Woodham said they have been very busy for the last two weeks.

With no further business to discuss, motion was made by Chairman Ellis and seconded by Commissioner Thompson that the Coffee County adjourn until the next meeting on July 28, 2025. All voted Aye.
