Those present at the said meeting were: Clint Grantham, Joey Powell, Jim Thompson, and Al Miller. Sonny Moore, Commissioner/Vice-Chairman, was presiding. Kim Ellis and Jimmy Jones were absent. John R. Morgan III, Administrator, Attorney, and Chief Operating Officer was also in attendance.

Vice-Chairman Moore noted that a quorum was present and called the meeting to order. He also gave the invocation followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Motion was made by Commissioner Miller and seconded by Commissioner Powell that the Coffee County Commission adopt the minutes from the January 12, 2026 meeting. All voted Aye.

Motion was made by Commissioner Miller and seconded by Commissioner Thompson that the Coffee County Commission authorize and approve a contract with ISS to replace the server software. All voted Aye.

Motion was made by Commissioner Grantham and seconded by Commissioner Powell that the Coffee County Commission reappoint Mayor Bill Cooper, Margaret Calhoun, and Rod Morgan to serve on the SARCOA Board. All voted Aye.

County Engineer/Deputy Operating Officer Michael Walters reminded everyone about the ALDOT Public Involvement meeting on Tuesday, January 27th from 5:00 pm to 7:00 pm at the New Brockton Senior Center proposing improving the traffic flow and address safety concerns on US 84 at the intersections with CR 514, CR 516, and CR 533.

EMA Director Grant Lyons updated the Commission on the weather. He said warming stations will be set up at the Christian Mission Center in Enterprise and at the Elba United Methodist Church.

County Agent Gavin Mauldin announced that a Restricted Use Pesticide class and testing will be held on February 17th in the Community Room.

Commissioner Thompson thanked the County as well as the City of Enterprise for working well together at a wreck on Salem Road.

With no further business to discuss, motion was made by Commissioner Thompson and seconded by Commissioner Grantham that the Coffee County Commission adjourn until the next meeting on February 9, 2026. All voted Aye.
