On this the 12th day of June 2017, the Coffee County Commission of Coffee County, AL met in a regular meeting in the Commission Chambers in New Brockton, AL at 9:00 AM. Those present at the said meeting were: Kim Ellis, Josh Carnley, Al Britt, Jimmy Jones, Jim Thompson and Tom Grimsley. Dean Smith, Commissioner and Chairman, was presiding with none absent. John R. Morgan III, Administrator/Attorney was also in attendance.

The Chairman noted that a quorum was present. The meeting was called to order with the invocation given by Commissioner Grimsley followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Motion was made by Commissioner Jones and seconded by Commissioner Carnley that the Coffee County Commission adopt the minutes of the May 22, 2017 meeting. All voted Aye.

Motion was made By Commissioner Smith and seconded by Commissioner Britt to initialize the paperwork to resurface CR342 from AL87 to CR349. All voted Aye.

County Engineer also requested initialization of the resolution to pave CR495. Motion was made by Commissioner Jones and seconded by Commissioner Carnley to approve request. All voted Aye.

Randy Tindell also presented resolution to execute the Shellfield Road project funding agreement. Motion was made by Commissioner Thompson and seconded by Commissioner Ellis to execute agreement. All voted Aye.

County Engineer also had a request from CCWA for an easement on AL87 to have access to a water line. Motion was made by Commissioner Smith and seconded by Commissioner Ellis to grant request. All voted Aye.

Larry Walker, EMA Director, updated the Commission on the siren project.

County Agent, Grant Lyons updated the Commission on the success of the County 4-H at the Regional Roundup. He also noted that 4-H Archer Christina Green qualified to go to Nationals .

With no further business, motion was made by Commissioner Britt and seconded by Commissioner Grimsley that the Coffee County Commission adjourn until the next meeting, June 26, 2017. All voted Aye.
