Morgan III, Administrator/Attorney, was also in attendance.

Motion was made by Commissioner Grimsley and seconded by Commissioner Jones that the Coffee County Commission adopt the minutes of the June 12, 2017 meeting. All voted Aye.

Sandy Bynum, Elba Chamber of Commerce, invited everyone to the Fourth of July Celebration that will be held on the east side of the Courthouse Tuesday, July 4, 2017 at 6:30.

Linda Blake, Voter Registrars , updated the Commission about Cross-over Voting Rules that are effective July 1, 2017.

John R. Morgan, Administrator, requested that the Commission approve an amendment to the contract with CivicPlus to add a Mass Alert System on the new website. The cost for the first year will be \$13,377.00 and the second year will be \$12,497.00. Motion was made by Commissioner Jones and seconded by Commissioner Thompson to add the Mass Alert System to the website. All voted Aye.

Sheriff Sutton updated the Commission on July 4th safety. He also noted phone scams have increased.

The Commissioners wished everyone a Happy Fourth of July.

With no further business, motion was made by Commissioner Ellis and seconded by Commissioner Carnley that the Coffee County Commission adjourn until the next meeting, July 10, 2017. All voted Aye.
