Morgan, Administrator and County Attorney was in attendance.

Mr. Josh Elliott, NRCS Director, came before the Commission to present its annual report. Mr. Kenneth Sanders, Board of Directors, thanked the Commission for their years of support. and extended an invitation to their meetings on the second Thursday in March.

Motion was made by Kim Ellis and seconded by Jimmy Jones that the Coffee County Commission award the bid for Glue Laminated Bridge Decking to Structural Wood Systems at \$35,310. This will be used on CR682 at Double Bridges Creek. All voted Aye.

EMA Director Larry Walker gave a weather update. No damages or injuries reported due to the recent severe weather. However, Enterprise reported 6 inches of rain, New Brockton reported 5 inches of rain, and Elba reported 4.5 inches of rain.

Commissioners thanked NRCS for the years of services rendered to the citizens of Coffee County.

With no further business, motion was made by Tom Grimsley and seconded by Josh Carnley that the Coffee County Commission adjourn until the next meeting, February 13, 2017. All voted Aye.
