Motion was made by Dean Smith and seconded by Jimmy Jones that the Coffee County Commission support the realignment of regions for Opportunity Act and that Coffee County make application to the local Southeast Region. All voted Aye.

Motion was made by Jimmy Jones and seconded by Al Britt that the Coffee County Commission approve selling 2004 Dodge Durango from the CCEMA. All voted Aye.

Motion was made by Jim Thompson and seconded by Al Britt that the Coffee County Commission rescind a prior policy to relocate driveways free of charge. All voted Aye.

Motion was made by Dean Smith and seconded by Tom Grimsley that the Coffee County Commission declare the rims for a JD Compactor as surplus and that they be sold on J.M. Wood Auction. All voted Aye.

Larry Walker, EMA Director, updated the Commission on the weather.

Sheriff Dave Sutton came before the Commission referencing Senate Bill #24. He advised that this is a dangerous gun bill dealing with public safety and urged everyone to contact their government representation to vote No on this bill.

With no further business, motion was made by Tom Grimsley and seconded by Al Britt that the Coffee County Commission adjourn until the next meeting, March 27, 2017. All voted Aye.
