Mr. Buddy Sharpless, former president of the ACCA, was in attendance and recognized and thanked for all that he did during his tenure to assist Coffee County.

Chairman Smith noted that April 15 through 22, 2017 is Don't Drop It on Alabama Clean-up Campaign sponsored through AL Pals. He urged everyone to participate in cleaning up Coffee County.
