On this the 22nd day of January 2018, the Coffee County Commission met in a regular meeting in the Commission Chambers in New Brockton, AL at 9:00 AM. Those present at the said meeting were: Kim Ellis, Josh Carnley, Al Britt, Jimmy Jones, Jim Thompson and Tom Grimsley. Dean Smith, Commissioner and Chairman, was presiding with none absent. John R. Morgan, Administrator/Attorney, was also in attendance.

The Chairman noted that a quorum was present and the meeting was called to order. Invocation was given by Commissioner Grimsley followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Demonstration was made by Frank Eason, IT Department, showing the Commission the new county website which is very user friendly.

Motion was made by Commissioner Grimsley and seconded by Commissioner Britt that the Coffee County Commission adopt the minutes of the January 8, 2018 meeting. All voted Aye.

Randy Tindell, County Engineer, requested permission from the Commission to list some equipment, other miscellaneous items, and office equipment on the GovDeals website. Motion was made by Commissioner Carnley and seconded by Commissioner Ellis that the Coffee County Commission grant permission to list the items on the GovDeals website. All voted Aye.

Motion was made by Commissioner Jones and seconded by Commissioner Grimsley authorizing the Chairman, County Administrator or County Engineer the ability to execute contracts for the new Administration Building for the Jail. All voted Aye.

Motion was made by Commissioner Ellis and seconded by Commissioner Jones to require applicants for jobs with the County to apply using the County Website. All voted Aye.

County Administrator, John R. Morgan thanked the Commission, CivicPlus, IT Department (Frank, Sharon and Paige), and Patti Culver for all their hard work on the website. He also thanked Tommy Dunaway for donating his time and talent for some of the pictures used on the new website.

Dean Blair came before the Commission to introduce the new Environmental Services employee, Cheyenne Stephens.

James Brown, EMA Director, updated the Commission on training events available for February and March.

County Agent, Gavin Mauldin also updated the Commission on events available at the Extension Office.

The Commissioners all welcomed the new county employee and thanked everyone who took part in making the new County Website.
