

February 12, 2018

On this the 12th day of February 2018, the Coffee County Commission met in a regular meeting in the Commission Chambers in New Brockton, AL at 9:00 AM. Those present at the said meeting were: Kim Ellis, Josh Carnley, Al Britt, Jimmy Jones, Jim Thompson and Tom Grimsley. Dean Smith, Commissioner and Chairman, was presiding with none absent. John R. Morgan, Administrator/Attorney, was also in attendance.

The Chairman noted that a quorum was present. The meeting was called to order and the invocation was given by Chairman Smith. The Pledge of Allegiance was led by the Enterprise JROTC.

Presentation was made to the area Coffee County Schools proclaiming February 2018 as Career and Technical Education Month.

Greg Piland, AL Forestry Commission, came before the Commission requesting a truck. Motion was made by Commissioner Carnley and seconded by Commissioner Grimsley to donate a 2013 Chevrolet Silverado to the Coffee County Forestry Commission. All voted Aye.

Motion was made by Commissioner Grimsley and seconded by Commissioner Jones that the Coffee County Commission adopt the minutes of the January 22, 2018 meeting. All voted Aye.

Randy Tindell, County Engineer, came before the Commission to request a resolution authorizing an agreement with ALDOT to resurface CR479 from the Geneva County line to AL52. Motion was made by Chairman Smith and seconded by Commissioner Jones to authorize the agreement. All voted Aye.

County Engineer also requested a resolution to enter into an agreement with ALDOT to resurface CR342 from AL87 to CR349. Motion was made by Chairman Smith and seconded by Commissioner Britt to authorize the agreement. All voted Aye.

Motion was made by Commissioner Ellis and seconded by Commissioner Thompson that the Coffee County Commission enter into an agreement with the City of Enterprise to provide on-call maintenance for seven caution lights in the County. All voted Aye.

Motion was made by Commissioner Britt and seconded by Commissioner Ellis to give the County Engineer permission to sell three vehicles on GovDeals. All voted Aye.

Motion was made by Commissioner Jones and seconded by Commissioner Carnley to execute an agreement with Coffee County Water Authority, City of Elba, Ben E. Keith and Kelley Foods to establish interconnection between Coffee County Water Authority and City of Elba water systems at the water tower adjacent to the Ben E. Keith facility in Elba to provide a redundant water source. All voted Aye.

Motion was made by Commissioner Grimsley and seconded by Commissioner Thompson to enter into an agreement with Coffee County Community Corrections to offer community corrections programs within the County. All voted Aye.

EMA Director, James Brown updated the Commission on rainfall totals for the County.

Sheriff Dave Sutton and all of the Commissioners thanked the students, teachers and administrators that participate in the Career Tech Program.

With no further business, motion was made by Commissioner Britt and seconded by Commissioner Ellis that the Coffee County Commission adjourn until the next meeting on February 26, 2018. All voted Aye.
