On this the 12th day of March 2018, the Coffee County Commission met in a regular meeting in the Commission Chambers in New Brockton, AL at 9:00 AM. Those present at the said meeting were: Kim Ellis, Josh Carnley, Al Britt, Jimmy Jones, Jim Thompson and Tom Grimsley. Dean Smith, Commissioner and Chairman, was presiding with none absent. John R. Morgan, Administrator/Attorney, was also in attendance.

The Chairman noted that a quorum was present. The meeting was called to order and the invocation was given by Commissioner Ellis, followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Resolution was presented by the Commission honoring Sheriff Dave Sutton for being elected by his peers to serve as President of the Alabama Sheriffs Association.

Motion was made by Commissioner Britt and seconded by Commissioner Grimsley that the Coffee County Commission authorize a request for proposal (RFP) for removal of the buildings on the property acquired from Dr. Oliver. All voted Aye.

Motion was made by Commissioner Carnley and seconded by Commissioner Thompson that the Coffee County Commission send out bids for the Publication of the Voters List. All voted Aye.

Rod Morgan, County Administrator, reminded everyone that the “Meet Your 2018 Primary Candidates” will be held tonight at 5:30 at the Enterprise Civic Center.

James Brown, EMA Director, updated the Commission on upcoming training events.

Gavin Mauldin, County Agent, updated the Commission on upcoming classes and events sponsored by the Extension Office.

Sheriff Sutton thanked the Commission for the Resolution honoring him.

Commissioner Thompson invited everyone to attend the Special Olympics at the Enterprise High School on April 6, 2018.

Commissioner Jones thanked the Commission for adding a third SRO.
