On this the 9th day of April 2018, the Coffee County Commission met in a regular meeting in the Commission Chambers in New Brockton, AL at 9:00 AM. Those present at the said meeting were: Kim Ellis, Josh Carnley, Al Britt, Jimmy Jones, Jim Thompson and Tom Grimsley. Dean Smith, Commissioner and Chairman, was presiding with none absent. John R. Morgan, Administrator/Attorney, was also in attendance.

The Chairman noted that a quorum was present and the meeting was called to order. The invocation was given by Commissioner Carnley followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mandi McPhaul, Career Coach for Coffee County and Elba City Schools, came before the Commission to request the Farm Center rental fee be waived for the Career Fair on Friday, April 13, 2018. Motion was by Commissioner Ellis and seconded by Commissioner Grimsley to waive the rental fee for the Farm Center. All voted Aye.

Emily Smith, Environmental Services, showed a slide presentation for the upcoming “Don’t Drop It on Alabama” campaign sponsored by AL PALS that will be held April 21st-28th. She encouraged all the citizens of Coffee County to participate.

Motion was made by Commissioner Ellis and seconded by Commissioner Grimsley proclaiming April 2018 as Child Abuse and Neglect Prevention Month. The Proclamation will be presented to DHR at a ceremony on Friday, April 13, 2018 at the Enterprise Courthouse. All voted Aye.

Motion was made by Commissioner Thompson and seconded by Commissioner Jones that the Coffee County Commission adopt the minutes from the March 26, 2018 meeting. All voted Aye.

EMA Director James Brown came before the Commission to request a resolution requiring all citizens in the unincorporated areas of Coffee County to have properly displayed addresses on their property. Motion was made by Commissioner Thompson and seconded by Commissioner Ellis to honor the request. All voted Aye.

Sarah Chapman, Board of Registrars, updated the Commission on voter registration dates for the upcoming June election.

Chairman Smith thanked everyone for the calls, texts, flowers and food received during the loss of his mother.

With no further business, motion was made by Commissioner Britt and seconded by Commissioner Grimsley that the Coffee County Commission adjourn until the next meeting on April 23, 2018. All voted Aye.
