On this the 25th day of June 2018, the Coffee County Commission met in a regular meeting in Commission Chambers in New Brockton, AL at 9:00 AM. Those present at the said meeting were: Kim Ellis, Josh Carnley, Al Britt, Jimmy Jones and Jim Thompson. Dean Smith, Commissioner and Chairman, was presiding with one absent, Tom Grimsley. John R. Morgan, Attorney/Administrator, was also in attendance.

The Chairman noted that a quorum was present and the meeting was called to order. Invocation was given by Commissioner Jones followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Motion was made by Commissioner Thompson and seconded by Commissioner Jones that the Coffee County Commission adopt the minutes of the June 11, 2018 meeting. All voted Aye.

Motion was made by Commissioner Ellis and seconded by Commissioner Jones that the Coffee County Commission authorize and approve entering into memorandum of understanding with the State Department of Human Resources to fix the roof at the County DHR Building. All voted Aye.

Motion was made by Chairman Smith and seconded by Commissioner Britt that the Coffee County Commission execute resolution between the County and the State of Alabama to resurface CR304 from CR305 northerly to the Pike County Line for approximately 3.66 miles. All voted Aye.

Charlie Webb, E911, stated that E911 is moving toward statewide integrated system.

Dean Blair, Environmental Services, noted that the garbage schedule will not change during the week of July 4th.

Linda Blake, Board of Registrars, stated Monday, July 2nd is the last day to register to vote in the July 17th runoff election.

With no further business, motion was made by Commissioner Carnley and seconded by Commissioner Jones that the Coffee County Commission adjourn until the next meeting on July 9, 2018. All voted Aye.
