On this the 13th day of August 2018, the Coffee County Commission met in a regular meeting in the Commission Chambers in New Brockton, AL at 9:00 AM. Those present at the said meeting were: Kim Ellis, Josh Carnley, Al Britt, Jim Thompson and Tom Grimsley. Dean Smith, Commissioner and Chairman, was presiding with one absent, Jimmy Jones. John R. Morgan, Attorney/Administrator, was also in attendance.

The Chairman noted that a quorum was present and the meeting was called to order. Invocation was given by Commissioner Grimsley followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Motion was made by Commissioner Grimsley and seconded by Commissioner Ellis that the Coffee County Commission adopt the minutes of the July 23, 2018 meeting. All voted Aye.

Motion was made by Commissioner Britt and seconded by Commissioner Carnley granting permission to send out annual bids for Pre-Event Debris Removal (Bid#2019-01) and Plant Mix (Bid#2019-02). All voted Aye.

Marty Lentz, Assistant Engineer, requested permission to sell the old copier used in the Engineer's Office on the GovDeals website. Motion was made by Commissioner Ellis and seconded by Commissioner Britt that the Coffee County Commission grant the request. All voted Aye.

Motion was made by Commissioner Carnley and seconded by Commissioner Britt that the Coffee County Commission grant the variance for the Goodman Acres Subdivision due to a change in regulations as recommended by Marty Lentz. All voted Aye.

Grant Lyons, EMA, updated the Commission on the 7th Annual Emergency Preparedness Fair that will be held on September 8, 2018 at the Enterprise Civic Center.

Marvin McIlwain, E-911, stressed the need for residents to get the 911 address signs to help first responders find their location in an emergency situation.
