

March 25, 2019

On this the 25th day of March 2019, the Coffee County Commission met in a regular meeting in the Commission Chambers in New Brockton, AL at 9:00 AM. Those present at the said meeting were: Al Britt, Jimmy Jones, Jim Thompson and Tom Grimsley. Dean Smith, Commissioner and Chairman, was presiding with Kim Ellis and Josh Carnley both absent. John R. Morgan III, Administrator/Attorney, was also in attendance.

Chairman Smith noted that a quorum was present and called the meeting to order. Invocation was given by Commissioner Grimsley followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Motion was made by Commissioner Jones and seconded by Commissioner Grimsley that the Coffee County Commission adopt the minutes of the March 11, 2019 meeting. All voted Aye.

Motion was made by Commissioner Jones and seconded by Commissioner Grimsley that the Coffee County Commission appoint Mrs. Carol Lane to serve on the Board of Directors for Southeast Alabama Community Action Partnership to replace Mayor William Cooper. All voted Aye.

Motion was made by Commissioner Thompson and seconded by Chairman Smith that the Coffee County Commission authorize the Industrial Access Grant Application for Project X. All voted Aye.

Motion was made by Commissioner Thompson and seconded by Commissioner Jones authorizing Environmental Services to purchase a 2002-8000 gallon double wall stainless steel tanker trailer for \$38,175.00. All voted Aye.

Motion was made by Commissioner Jones and seconded by Commissioner Grimsley that the Coffee County Commission pass a resolution supporting bill to increase the number of working days the Coffee County Board of Registrars may meet from a maximum of 199 working days each fiscal year to 220 working days each fiscal year. All voted Aye.

Assistant County Engineer Michael Walters came before the Commission to request permission to send out bids for aluminized corrugated metal pipe. Motion was made by Commissioner Britt and seconded by Commissioner Thompson that the Coffee County Commission honor the request. All voted Aye.

Marvin McIlwain, E-911, updated the Commission on the issues with the VoIP.
