Those present at the said meeting were: Kim Ellis, Josh Carnley, Al Britt, Jimmy Jones, Jim Thompson and Tom Grimsley. Dean Smith, Commissioner and Chairman, was presiding. John R. Morgan III, Administrator/Attorney, was not in attendance.

Chairman Smith noted that a quorum was present and called the meeting to order. Commissioner Jones gave the invocation followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Motion was made by Commissioner Grimsley and seconded by Commissioner Jones that the Coffee County Commission adopt the minutes from the February 24, 2020 meeting. All voted Aye.

Motion was made by Commissioner Carnley and seconded by Commissioner Britt that the Coffee County Commission appoint Mayor William Cooper, Commissioner Kim Ellis and Mrs. Margaret Calhoun to represent Coffee County on the SARCOA Board. All voted Aye.

Motion was made by Commissioner Grimsley and seconded by Commissioner Britt that the Coffee County Commission execute a Memorandum of Agreement with ALDOT to receive a \$400,000 allocation for the Rebuild Alabama Act. All voted Aye.

Dean Blair, E911, stated the Computer Aided Dispatch (CAD) at the Elba Police Department was up and running.

County Agent Gavin Mauldin stated that a Garden Workshop will be held on the 13th in the Community Room and a Watershed Training will be on the 19th at the Farmers Market. The Extension Office will also have a laptop available for citizens to fill out the 2020 Census starting on the 12th.

Registrar Sarah Chapman updated the Commission on voter turnout.

With no further business, motion was made by Commissioner Grimsley and seconded by Commissioner Ellis that the Coffee County Commission adjourn until the next meeting on March 23, 2020. All voted Aye.
