Those present at the said meeting were: Kim Ellis, Josh Carnley, Al Britt, Jimmy Jones, Jim Thompson and Tom Grimsley. Dean Smith, Commissioner and Chairman, was presiding with none absent. John R. Morgan III, Administrator/Attorney, was also in attendance.

Chairman Smith noted that a quorum was present and called the meeting to order. Invocation was given by Commissioner Britt followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Motion was made by Commissioner Grimsley and seconded by Commissioner Britt that the Coffee County Commission adopt the minutes from the March 22, 2021 meeting. All voted Aye.

Motion was made by Commissioner Thompson and seconded by Commissioner Ellis that the Coffee County Commission enter into an agreement with HireQuest to hire temporary labor to pick up litter on the side of county highways. All voted Aye.

County Administrator Rod Morgan encourages everyone to wear masks in county buildings and noted that masks are still required to enter courtrooms pursuant to court orders.

EMA Director James Brown updated the Commission on COVID. One hundred twelve people have died in Coffee County since the start of the virus.

County Agent Gavin Mauldin updated the Commission on upcoming events.

Sheriff Sutton stated that the freedom rally went well.

Commissioner Jones extended condolences to the families who lost loved ones due to COVID.

With no further business, motion was made by Commissioner Carnley and seconded by Commissioner Grimsley that the Coffee County Commission adjourn until the next meeting on April 26, 2021. All voted Aye.
