On this the 26th day of July 2021, the Coffee County Commission met in Commission Chambers in New Brockton, AL at 9:00 AM. Those present at the said meeting were: Kim Ellis, Josh Carnley, Al Britt and Jim Thompson. Dean Smith, Commissioner and Chairman, was presiding. Jimmy Jones and Tom Grimsley were absent. John R. Morgan III, Administrator/Attorney, was also in attendance.

Chairman Smith noted that a quorum was present and called the meeting to order. He also gave the invocation followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Motion was made by Commissioner Thompson and seconded by Commissioner Britt that the Coffee County Commission adopt the minutes from the July 12, 2021 meeting. All voted Aye.

Motion was made by Commissioner Thompson and seconded by Commissioner Carnley that the Coffee County Commission authorize and approve a loan with Synovus Bank for the construction of Cell 8 at the Coffee County Landfill. All voted Aye.

County Engineer Marty Lentz stated that a portion of County Road 239 will be closed Tuesday and Wednesday to replace drainage pipes.

Motion was made by Commissioner Carnley and seconded by Commissioner Ellis that the Coffee County Commission allow the surplus and sell of two garbage trucks on GovDeals as requested by Environmental Services Director Mike Thornton. All voted Aye.

EMA Director James Brown stated that COVID numbers are rising. He encouraged everyone to get a vaccine, wear a mask and social distance to help control the spread.

Dean Blair, E911 Chairman, also encouraged everyone to get the vaccine.

Chairman Smith congratulated Administrator Rod Morgan for being elected the 2021-2022 president of the Association of County Administrators Alabama (ACAA).

With no further business, motion was made by Commissioner Britt and seconded by Commissioner Ellis that the Coffee County Commission adjourn until the next meeting on August 9, 2021. All voted Aye.
