Those present at the said meeting were: Kim Ellis, Josh Carnley, Al Britt, Jimmy Jones, Jim Thompson and Tom Grimsley. Dean Smith, Commissioner and Chairman, was presiding with none absent. John R. Morgan III, Administrator/Attorney, was also in attendance.

Motion was made by Commissioner Jones and seconded by Commissioner Ellis that the Coffee County Commission adopt a resolution establishing the National Incident Management System (NIMS) to be utilized by the Coffee County EMA for all incident management in Coffee County, Alabama. All voted Aye.

Motion was made by Commissioner Smith and seconded by Commissioner Carnley that the Coffee County Commission authorize a memorandum of understanding with the City of Elba and Elba City Schools to provide a School Resource Officer. All voted Aye.

James Brown, EMA Director, updated the Commission on COVID.

E911 Director Dean Blair and Sheriff Sutton thanked the Commission for adding a School Resource Officer at Elba City Schools.

With no further business, motion was made by Commissioner Grimsley and seconded by Commissioner Britt that the Coffee County Commission adjourn until the next meeting. All voted Aye.
