On this the 22nd day of November 2021, the Coffee County Commission met in a regular meeting in Commission Chambers in New Brockton, AL at 9:00 AM. Those present at the said meeting were: Kim Ellis, Josh Carnley, Al Britt, Jimmy Jones, Jim Thompson and Tom Grimsley. Dean Smith, Commissioner and Chairman, was presiding with none absent. John R. Morgan III, Administrator/Attorney, was also in attendance.

Chairman Smith noted that a quorum was present and called the meeting to order. Invocation was given by Commissioner Britt followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

A public hearing was held concerning a proposed redistricting plan for the County. Scott Farmer was present to answer any questions. No one came forward to speak and the public hearing was concluded.

Representatives from Enterprise Rescue came before the Commission to thank them for the new critical care ambulance that was provided from the Cares Act Funding. They also invited the Commissioners to look at the new equipment after the meeting was adjourned.

Representatives from Wiregrass Men of Valor came before the Commission to present a \$500 donation to Mrs. Judy Crowley with Coffee County Family Services to purchase bikes for the Toys for Tots event on December 17, 2021.

Motion was made by Commissioner Grimsley and seconded by Commissioner Jones that the Coffee County Commission adopt the minutes from the October 25, 2021 meeting. All voted Aye.

Motion was made by Commissioner Carnley and seconded by Commissioner Thompson that the Coffee County Commission adopt the redistricting plan as presented to the Commission and advertised. All voted Aye.

Commissioner Jones wished everyone a Happy Thanksgiving and thanked Enterprise Rescue as well as Medical Center Enterprise for their service during the pandemic.

Commissioner Britt thanked Enterprise Rescue and Mrs. Judy Crowley with Coffee County Family Services for serving the citizens of Coffee County.

Commissioner Ellis reminded everyone to be thankful for all the things the good Lord has given us and to remember our older adults.

Commissioner Grimsley wanted everyone to have a Happy & Safe Thanksgiving. He thanked Mr. Farmer for working on the redistricting map. He also thanked Judy Crowley and Enterprise Rescue for the services they provide for our county.
