On this the 28<sup>th</sup> day of March 2022, the Coffee County Commission met in a regular meeting in Commission Chambers in New Brockton, AL at 9:00 AM. Those present at the said meeting were: Kim Ellis, Josh Carnley, Al Britt, Jimmy Jones, Jim Thompson and Tom Grimsley. Dean Smith, Commissioner and Chairman, was presiding. John R. Morgan III, Administrator/Attorney, was absent.

Chairman Smith noted that a quorum was present and called the meeting to order. He also gave the invocation followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Motion was made by Commissioner Grimsley and seconded by Commissioner Jones that the Coffee County Commission adopt the minutes from the March 14, 2022 meeting. All voted Aye.

Melissa Glavan, Chief Accounting Officer, read the results of a bid opening held on March 1, 2022 at 9:00 AM:

Motion was made by Commissioner Carnley and seconded by Commissioner Thompson that the Coffee County Commission award Bid#2022-16 to the Southeast Sun. All voted Aye.

County Engineer Marty Lentz submitted an application to the Rebuild Alabama Act \$10,000,000 grant program and received a grant of \$250,000 to go toward the resurfacing project on CR239 from the intersection CR239 and CR248 to AL167.

Motion was made by Commissioner Ellis and seconded by Commissioner Britt that the Coffee County Commission grant permission to County Engineer Marty Lentz to surplus a 2014 Chevrolet C1500 truck that has transmission issues and sell it as is on GovDeals. All voted Aye.

Motion was made by Commissioner Jones and seconded by Commissioner Britt that the Coffee County Commission allow the engineer to place an order for two T226 MowerMax machines off the State Bid for delivery in September to replace the current tractors with boom cutters. All voted Aye.

Mike Thornton, Environmental Services, read the results of Bid#2022-18- 826K Compactor Axle Repair. Thompson Tractor was the only respondent with the price of \$54,723.86. Motion was made by Commissioner Jones and seconded by Commissioner Ellis that the Coffee County Commission award Bid#2022-18 to Thompson Tractor. All voted Aye.

EMA Director James Brown updated the Commission on weather that is coming in Wednesday afternoon.

Registrar Denine Richey updated the Commission on the upcoming election. The Absentee Office will open on April 30<sup>th</sup> and the last day to register to vote is May 9<sup>th</sup>.
