On this the 11<sup>th</sup> day of April 2022, the Coffee County Commission met in Commission Chambers in New Brockton, AL at 9:00 AM. Those present at the said meeting were: Kim Ellis, Al Britt, Jimmy Jones, Jim Thompson and Tom Grimsley. Josh Carnley, Commissioner and Vice-Chairman, was presiding. Dean Smith was absent. John R. Morgan III, Administrator/Attorney, was also in attendance.

Vice-Chairman Carnley noted that a quorum was present and called the meeting to order. Invocation was given by Commissioner Ellis followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

A proclamation was presented to Kaley Green, Pike Regional Child Advocacy Center, proclaiming April 2022 as "Child Abuse and Neglect Prevention Month".

Motion was made by Commissioner Grimsley and seconded by Commissioner Britt that the Coffee County Commission adopt the minutes from the March 28, 2022 meeting. All voted Aye.

Motion was made by Commissioner Jones and seconded by Commissioner Ellis that the Coffee County Commission adopt the updated Flood Damage Prevention Plan. All voted Aye.

Motion was made by Commissioner Thompson and seconded by Commissioner Britt that the Coffee County Commission award Bid#2022-17-Inmate Communications System to Combined Public Communications. All voted Aye.

Motion was made by Commissioner Jones and seconded by Commissioner Thompson that the Coffee County Commission authorize and approve a lease agreement with the State of Alabama to provide an office for the State Bureau of Investigation in Enterprise. All voted Aye.

Motion was made by Commissioner Grimsley and seconded by Commissioner Jones that the Coffee County Commission allow County Engineer Marty Lentz to surplus and sell some engine oils and transmission fluids that the County no longer uses on GovDeals. All voted Aye.

Motion was made by Commissioner Ellis and seconded by Commissioner Britt that the Coffee County Commission grant permission to bid a 2019 or newer four-wheel drive truck for the Landfill Foreman as requested by Environmental Services Director Mike Thornton. All voted Aye.

EMA Director James Brown updated the Commission on upcoming events. A CERT training class will be held at Enterprise Rescue on May 13th & 14th.

Dean Blair, 911, stated that first responders will be holding a Prom Promise Event at New Brockton High School on Wednesday at 9:00 AM.

Registrar Denine Richey updated the Commission on voter information.

With no further business, motion was made by Commissioner Grimsley and seconded by Commissioner Thompson that the Coffee County Commission adjourn until the next meeting on April 25, 2022. All voted Aye.
