On this the 13th day of June 2022, the Coffee County Commission met in Commission Chambers in New Brockton, AL at 9:00 AM. Those present at the said meeting were: Kim Ellis, Josh Carnley, Al Britt, Jimmy Jones, Jim Thompson and Tom Grimsley. Dean Smith, Commissioner and Chairman, was presiding with none absent. John R. Morgan III, Administrator/Attorney, was also in attendance.

Chairman Smith noted that a quorum was present and called the meeting to order. Invocation was given by Commissioner Britt followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Motion was made by Commissioner Grimsley and seconded by Commissioner Jones that the Coffee County Commission adopt the minutes from the May 23, 2022 meeting. All voted Aye.

County Administrator Rod Morgan stated that the runoff election is on June 21st and Friday, June 17th is the last day to hand deliver absentee ballots.

Motion was made by Commissioner Carnley and seconded by Commissioner Ellis that the Coffee County Commission grant permission to surplus and sell a HVAC system and two bush wacker mowers on GovDeals as requested by County Engineer Marty Lentz. All voted Aye.

Mike Thornton, Environmental Services, stated that the garbage routes will run as normal on Monday, June 20, 2022.

EMA Director James Brown gave an update on the heat advisory for Tuesday and Wednesday.

Motion was made by Commissioner Britt and seconded by Commissioner Thompson that the Coffee County Commission approve the reappointment of Grant Lyons and Mary Katherine Head to serve another 4-year term on the 911 Board. All voted Aye.

County Agent Gavin Mauldin updated the Commission on upcoming events.

Registrar Shannon Smith stated that Denine Richey turned in her resignation as a registrar effective June 30, 2022.

Sheriff Sutton stated that Chief Deputy Whitworth received an award.

With no further business, motion was made by Commissioner Grimsley and seconded by Commissioner Jones that the Coffee County Commission adjourn until the next meeting on June 27, 2022. All voted Aye.
