

November 14, 2022

On this the 14th day of November 2022, the Coffee County Commission met in Commission Chambers in New Brockton, AL at 9:00 AM. Those present at the said meeting were: Kim Ellis, Al Britt, Jimmy Jones, Jim Thompson and Tom Grimsley. Dean Smith, Commissioner and Chairman, was presiding with one vacancy in District 3. John R. Morgan III, Administrator/Attorney, was also in attendance.

Chairman Smith noted that a quorum was present and called the meeting to order. Invocation was given by Commissioner Ellis followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Chairman Smith read the Farm City Proclamation declaring November 18-24, 2022 as Alabama Farm City Week. Mayors from Elba, Enterprise and New Brockton were present and signed the proclamation.

Motion was made by Commissioner Grimsley and seconded by Commissioner Jones that the Coffee County Commission adopt the minutes from the October 24, 2022 meeting. All voted Aye.

A bid opening for the Landfill Gas Collection Expansion System was discussed at the work session last week. Five bids were received; however, three responses were incomplete. County Administrator Rod Morgan recommended disqualifying the incomplete bids as nonresponsive and awarding the bid to the lowest responsive bidder, Carlson Environmental, in the amount of \$1,260,744.00. Motion was made by Commissioner Ellis and seconded by Commissioner Thompson that the Coffee County Commission award the bid to Carlson Environmental. All voted Aye.

County Agent Gavin Mauldin updated the Commission on upcoming events. The Farm City Banquet is Thursday night at the Farm Center. Doors will open at 5:30 and the event will start at 6:00. The 4-H Wiregrass Hog Show is this Saturday.

Jessie Quillen, Wiregrass Economic Development, updated the Commission on the labor force increases in the county this year.

Commissioner Jones thanked all the farmers in Coffee County for their hard work and dedication to provide food for our families.

With no further business, motion was made by Commissioner Grimsley and seconded by Commissioner Britt that the Coffee County Commission adjourn until the next meeting on November 28, 2022. All voted Aye.
