

March 13, 2023

On this the 13th day of March 2023, the Coffee County Commission met in Commission Chambers in New Brockton, AL at 9:00 AM. Those present at the said meeting were: Kim Ellis, Sonny Moore, Jimmy Jones, Jim Thompson and Tom Grimsley. Dean Smith, Commissioner/Chairman, was presiding. Al Britt was absent. John R. Morgan III, Administrator/Attorney, was also in attendance.

Chairman Smith noted that a quorum was present and called the meeting to order. Invocation was given by Commissioner Grimsley followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Motion was made by Commissioner Grimsley and seconded by Commissioner Moore that the Coffee County Commission adopt the minutes from the February 27, 2023 meeting. All voted Aye.

Motion was made by Commissioner Thompson and seconded by Commissioner Moore that the Coffee County Commission replace a D1 dozer at the Landfill and purchase a new one for \$159,868.77 off Sourcewell. All voted Aye.

Motion was made by Commissioner Ellis and seconded by Commissioner Jones that the Coffee County Commission adopt the new rental policy for county buildings as presented by County Administrator Rod Morgan. Commissioners Ellis, Moore, Jones, Thompson and Grimsley voted Aye. Chairman Smith was opposed. This motion passed 5-1.

Motion was made by Commissioner Smith and seconded by Commissioner Jones that the Coffee County Commission reappoint Kenneth Baker and Tommy Brooks to serve on the Coffee County Water Authority Board. All voted Aye.

County Engineer Marty Lentz read the results of a bid opening held on March 8, 2023 at 10:00 AM:

Motion was made by Commissioner Ellis and seconded by Commissioner Moore that the Coffee County Commission award Bid#2023-17 to Twin Oaks Environmental. All voted Aye.

Motion was made by Commissioner Grimsley and seconded by Commissioner Jones that the Coffee County Commission allow County Engineer Marty Lentz to sell a mulching head on the ACCA Marketplace and purchase a rotary head. All voted Aye.

EMA Deputy Director Grant Lyons thanked everyone who participated in the active shooter exercise held last week. He also encouraged everyone to go to coffeecounty.us and click on Emergency Management to sign up for mass notifications to receive emergency alerts.

Commissioner Thompson attended the active shooter exercise and was amazed by how well the different groups of first responders worked together.

Commissioner Moore thanked the media for covering the training exercise.

With no further business, motion was made by Commissioner Grimsley and seconded by Commissioner Thompson that the Coffee County Commission adjourn until the next meeting on March 27, 2023. All voted Aye.
