On this the 27th day of March 2023, the Coffee County Commission met in Commission Chambers in New Brockton, AL at 9:00 AM. Those present at the said meeting were: Kim Ellis, Jimmy Jones, Jim Thompson and Tom Grimsley. Dean Smith, Commissioner/Chairman, was presiding. Sonny Moore and Al Britt were both absent. John R. Morgan III, Administrator/Attorney, was also in attendance.

Chairman Smith noted that a quorum was present and called the meeting to order. Invocation was given by Commissioner Grimsley followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Motion was made by Commissioner Jones and seconded by Commissioner Grimsley that the Coffee County Commission adopt the minutes from the March 13, 2023 meeting. All voted Aye.

Motion was made by Commissioner Ellis and seconded by Commissioner Smith that the Coffee Commission reappoint Mayor William Cooper, Mr. Rod Morgan and Mrs. Margaret Calhoun to represent Coffee County on the SARCOA Board. All voted Aye.

Motion was made by Commissioner Thompson and seconded by Commissioner Grimsley that the Coffee County Commission support a local law regarding the chief deputy coroner and deputy coroner. All voted Aye.

Motion was made by Commissioner Thompson and seconded by Commissioner Jones that the Coffee County Commission authorize a contract with Glenda Baxter to prepare financial statements for the county. All voted Aye.

Motion was made by Commissioner Jones and seconded by Commissioner Thompson that the Coffee County Commission accept a proposal from RHC Incorporated to replace the kitchen floor drains in the jail for \$30,563.48. All voted Aye.

County Engineer Marty Lentz provided an estimated summary for ten roads for FY2023 Coffee County resurfacing projects totaling \$5,235,225.00.

Motion was made by Commissioner Thompson and seconded by Commissioner Grimsley that the Coffee County Commission approve the proposed plat for a minor subdivision, The Estates on Boy Scout Road, located on CR156. All voted Aye.

Motion was made by Commissioner Smith and seconded by Commissioner Ellis that the Coffee County Commission approve the purchase of a 2015 1-ton flat bed truck for \$31,000.00 off the State Surplus for the additional litter pick up crew as requested by County Engineer Marty Lentz. All voted Aye.

EMA Deputy Director Grant Lyons updated the Commission on the recent hail damage in Elba.

County Agent Gavin Mauldin gave an update on the Coffee County Youth Leadership Program.

Sheriff Byrd stated they conducted an operation for traffic control on Saturday from 12 noon until 11 PM.

With no further business to discuss, motion was made by Commissioner Grimsley and seconded by Commissioner Ellis that the Coffee County Commission adjourn until the next meeting on April 10, 2023. All voted Aye.
