

May 22, 2023

On this the 22<sup>nd</sup> day of May 2023, the Coffee County Commission met in Commission Chambers in New Brockton, AL at 9:00 AM. Those present at the said meeting were: Kim Ellis, Sonny Moore, Jimmy Jones, Jim Thompson and Tom Grimsley. Dean Smith, Commissioner/Chairman, was presiding. Al Britt was absent. John R. Morgan III, Administrator/Attorney, was also in attendance.

Chairman Smith noted that a quorum was present and called the meeting to order. Invocation was given by Commissioner Ellis followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Revenue Commissioner Ronnie Burns came before the Commission to present the annual tax settlement report for FY2022. Motion was made by Commissioner Thompson and seconded by Commissioner Jones that the Coffee County Commission accept the report as read. All voted Aye.

Chairman Smith presented a proclamation declaring May 21-27, 2023, as Emergency Medical Services Week in Coffee County.

Motion was made by Commissioner Grimsley and seconded by Commissioner Moore that the Coffee County Commission adopt the minutes from the May 8, 2023 meeting. All voted Aye.

County Administrator Rod Morgan read the results of a bid opening held on May 15, 2023 at 2:00 PM:

Motion was made by Commissioner Thompson and seconded by Commissioner Ellis that the Coffee County Commission award Bid#2023-19 to Seminole Communications. All voted Aye.

County Engineer Marty Lentz gave an update on the resurfacing project on CR636. The contractor is currently working on the turn lanes and intersections.

Mike Thornton, Environmental Services, asked for permission to purchase wheels for a 826 Compactor at the Landfill from the Sourcewell bid for \$62,474.00. Motion was made by Commissioner Ellis and seconded by Commissioner Moore that the Coffee County Commission allow the purchase. All voted Aye.

Garbage routes will run on Memorial Day and the Landfill will be open.

Dean Blair, 911, thanked Enterprise Rescue and all the first responders for providing quality care for our citizens.

Sheriff Byrd thanked the Commission for all their support. He also thanked Enterprise Rescue for assisting with high risk warrants.

The commissioners all thanked our first responders for their hard work and dedication and congratulated County Administrator Rod Morgan for being awarded Administrator of the Year in Alabama last week.

With no further business to discuss, motion was made by Commissioner Grimsley and seconded by Commissioner Thompson that the Coffee County Commission adjourn until the next meeting on June 12, 2023. All voted Aye.
