

June 26, 2023

On this the 26th day of June 2023, the Coffee County Commission met in Commission Chambers in New Brockton, AL at 9:00 AM. Those present at the said meeting were: Sonny Moore, Jimmy Jones, Jim Thompson and Tom Grimsley. Dean Smith, Commissioner/Chairman, was presiding the meeting. Kim Ellis and Al Britt were absent. John R. Morgan III, Administrator/Attorney, was in attendance.

Chairman Smith noted that a quorum was present and called the meeting to order. Invocation was given by Commissioner Moore followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Motion was made by Commissioner Grimsley and seconded by Commissioner Jones that the Coffee County Commission adopt the minutes from the June 12, 2023 meeting. All voted Aye.

Motion was made by Commissioner Thompson and seconded by Commissioner Jones that the Coffee County Commission approve the Mapping and Appraisal budget of \$984,299.00 contingent upon approval of the FY 2023-2024 budget. All voted Aye.

Motion was made by Commissioner Moore and seconded by Commissioner Grimsley that the Coffee County Commission reappoint Terry Wilkins, Dale Grimes and Adair Lee to serve on the 911 Board. All voted Aye.

Motion was made by Commissioner Thompson and seconded by Commissioner Moore that the Coffee County Commission allow the Sheriff's office to surplus and replace desks in the Deputy Hut. All voted Aye.

Motion was made by Commissioner Jones and seconded by Commissioner Smith that the Coffee County Commission authorize the submission of a grant application to ADEM for up to a \$150,000 to replace thirteen cross drain pipes. All voted Aye.

Motion was made by Commissioner Grimsley and seconded by Commissioner Smith that the Coffee County Commission approve a resolution to participate in the joint application to develop, through the help of an engineering consultant, AECOM of Birmingham, a planning grant for the Bridge Investment Program with thirty-three other counties. All voted Aye.

Grant Lyons, EMA Deputy Director, said the state will come down on Thursday to access the June 12th-16th storm damage.

Dean Blair, 911, thanked the Commission for the board reappointments.

Brent Melton, Environmental Services, stated there are no changes to the garbage route on July 4th.

County Agent Gavin Mauldin updated the Commission on upcoming events.

All the commissioners thanked county employees for working long hours during the recent storms.

With no further business to discuss, motion was made by Commissioner Grimsley and seconded by Commissioner Thompson that the Coffee County Commission adjourn until the next meeting on July 10, 2023. All voted Aye.
