

July 24, 2023

On this the 24th day of July 2023, the Coffee County Commission met in Commission Chambers in New Brockton, AL at 9:00 AM. Those present at the said meeting were: Kim Ellis, Sonny Moore, Jimmy Jones, Jim Thompson and Tom Grimsley. Dean Smith, Commissioner/Chairman, was presiding. Al Britt was absent. John R. Morgan III, Administrator/Attorney, was also in attendance.

Chairman Smith noted that a quorum was present and called the meeting to order. Invocation was given by Commissioner Jones followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Chairman Smith presented a resolution recognizing the Elba High School FCCLA for placing first or second and earning gold at nationals in Colorado.

Motion was made by Commissioner Grimsley and seconded by Commissioner Thompson that the Coffee County Commission adopt the minutes from the June 26, 2023 meeting. All voted Aye.

Motion was made by Commissioner Moore and seconded by Commissioner Jones that the Coffee County Commission reallocate sixteen days from Kathy Newsome in the Board of Registrar's office and give eight days to Juleigh Ayers and eight days to Lisa Treglia. All voted Aye.

Motion was made by Commissioner Jones and seconded by Commissioner Moore that the Coffee County Commission nominate Chairman Dean Smith to serve as the Coffee County representative on the ACCA Legislative Committee. All voted Aye.

Motion was made by Commissioner Ellis and seconded by Commissioner Grimsley that the Coffee County Commission grant permission to send out bids for tanker loads of diesel fuel as requested by County Engineer Marty Lentz. All voted Aye.

EMA Director James Brown updated the Commission on the FEMA storm damage assessment.

Dean Blair, 911, updated the Commission on the progress of the new dispatch center. He also stated that Charlie Webb passed away last Wednesday.

Mike Thornton, Environmental Services, read the results of a bid opening held July 14, 2023 for two new trucks. The only respondent was Donohoo Chevrolet with a bid of \$48,923 per truck. Motion was made by Commissioner Thompson and seconded by Commissioner Moore that the Coffee County Commission award Bid#2023-20 to Donohoo Chevrolet. All voted Aye.

All the commissioners thanked the Elba High School FCCLA for their presentation and congratulated them on their hard work and success at nationals.

With no further business to discuss, motion was made by Commissioner Grimsley and seconded by Commissioner Thompson that the Coffee County Commission adjourn until their next meeting on August 14, 2023. All voted Aye.
